1	IT Sub-committee: To assist the HPPA in web content maintenance, and to help promote the use of Information Technology (IT) among the HPPS teachers, pupils and parents; and to provide IT infrastructure support to HPPS and HPPA.		
2	Membership & Feedback Sub-committee: To maintain and update membership database; conduct membership recruitment drive; maintain the discussion list of the HPPA and the bulletin board; to notify members about major events happening in the School eg. AGM, social events; and to respond and/or act on members' feedback.
