Targeted Coach-to-Student ratio is 1 to 8 max. so that pupils can have a balance of fun, exposure and training to build a good foundation for potential advancement.

Outstanding students from the program MAY have the opportunity to be selected for the School Feeder Teams and the School Teams in the future.

Two separate **classes**: every **Tuesday and Thursday** from **10:15am to 12:15pm**, starting from **13 Jan 2009** at School's Tennis Court.

FREE additional lessons: Participants can attend free additional lessons at Waterfront Sports' training centre located at 7 Japanese Garden Road during the school semester from 10am to 12pm (Saturday). There are six tennis courts at the training centre.



Fees : Beginners - 10 weeks 1½ hrs @ **\$200** per school term
Juniors - 10 weeks 2 hrs @ **\$250** per school term

Non-HPPA members need to pay extra S\$20 registration fee per family per year per ECCA enrolled

There are limited numbers of places available. This program is opened to P1 pupils on a first-come, first-served basis. Pupils with parents volunteering their help stand a better chance of being accepted especially if application forms are received through our mailbox and file tray. No refund will be given for accepted participants. Only pupils satisfying the prevailing School's CCA attendance requirements will have their record recognized in their school report books.

Value-adding arrangement

Due to the fact that these are young pupils attending the afternoon session, the coaches and parent volunteers will lead them for cleaning, change clothes and will ensure pupils consume their lunch (self-packed or purchased) at the canteen before releasing them.

Background of Waterfront Sports Pte Ltd (www.waterfrontsports.com.sg)

Waterfront Sports Pte Ltd, previously known as Waterfront Tennis Pte Ltd, was incorporated on 29th September 1999. It used to manage its operations at Singapore Tennis Centre located at East Coast Parkway until 2004. Waterfront Sports Pte Ltd has been training the school teams as well as the feeder team for both the boys and girls since January 2007. In September 2008, some primary 1 and 2 students were selected to form the junior feeder team.

Planned programmes:

School Semester Training (10 weeks)

i. 10 weeks Training Programme - Beginner

This 90-minute weekly training programme will be held during week-days morning at the school's tennis court.

The programme covers basic hand eye co-ordination, ball sense and basic technical drills and skills (racket and simple footwork movement) for total beginners.

ii. 10 weeks Training Programme - Junior

Players who are able to / already have the basic or necessary foundations will be monitored and placed under this programme which will also be held during week-days morning at the school's tennis court.

This programme emphasises on the strong foundation of technical drills and skill proficiency covering both racket and essential footwork movement.

These players will also be monitored and promoted to the feeder team programme when appropriate.

Waterfront Sports Pte Ltd actively seeks to promote tennis as a sport and a social activity in Singapore through its proven programmes. It hopes that this would help to lay the foundation for a long and mutually beneficial relationship with Henry Park Primary School and Henry Park Primary School Parents' Association.
